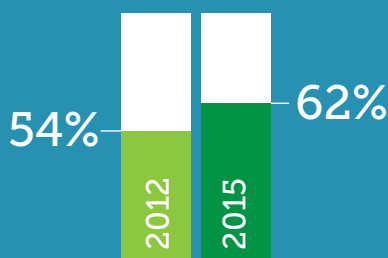

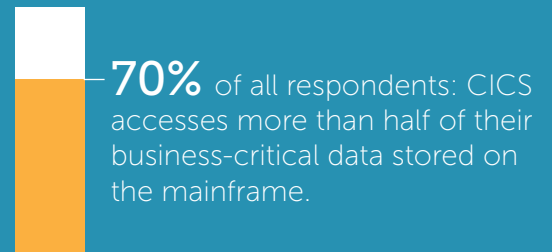

Those who said more than half of their business-critical applications are used online through CICS.

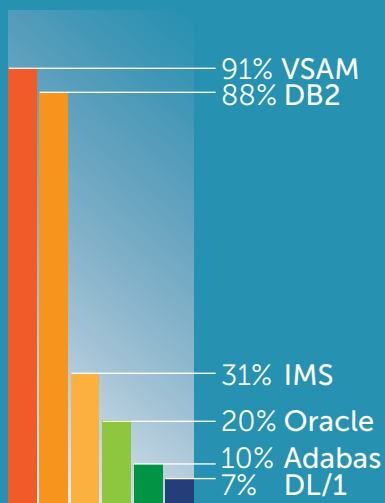
BUSINESS-CRITICAL DATA

"CICS processes 30 billion transactions a day, and in the course of a week those transactions are valued at \$1 trillion dollars." – IBM's Martin Keen

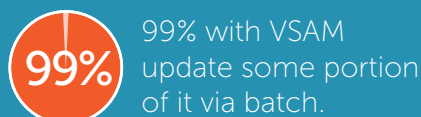
